Alhumdulillah, the Ramadhaan timetable is agreed by the Masaajid of Luton. Fajr and Maghrib jamaat will start 10 minutes after Fajr start time and Iftaar time, (insha-Allah).

Ibn 'Abbas said: The Prophet (peace be upon him) enjoined Sadaqaat-ul-Fitr so that those who fast are purified of their errors and the poor and needy people are enabled to arrange for their basic needs of food, clothing etc. Therefore, the Sadaqah of the person who gives before the Eid prayer is the real Sadaqah, but if someone delays and gives it afterward his charity will be an ordinary charity. (Abu Dawud and Ibn Majah).

PRAYER TO BEGIN THE FAST

وَبِصَوْمِ غَدٍ نَّوَيْتُ مِنْ شَهْرِ رَمَضَانَ

I intend to fast tomorrow in the Month of Ramadhaan.

PRAYER TO END THE FAST

اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي لَكَ صُمْتُ وَبِكَ آمَنْتُ وَ عَلَى رِزْقِكَ أَفْطَرْتُ

Oh Allah! Verily I have fasted on your behest and believed in you and I am ending (my fast) with the sustenance that you provide.

PRAYER FOR THE MONTH OF RAMADHAAN

اللَّهُمَّ إِنَّكَ عَفُوٌّ تُحِبُّ الْعَفْوَ فَاعْفُ عَنِّي

Oh Allah! You are surely most forgiving and you like forgiving, so forgive me.
