This amount must be paid before Eid. We are encouraged to pay it during Ramadhan so that those in need can benefit in good time.

-enjoined Sadaqat-ul صَلَى ٱللهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمُ said: The Prophet صَلَّى ٱللهُ عَنْهُ enjoined Sadaqat-ul Fitr so that those who fast are purified of their errors and the poor and needy people are enabled to arrange for their basic needs of food, clothing etc. Therefore, the Sadagah of the person who gives before the Eid prayer is the real Sadaqah, but if someone delays and gives it afterward his charity will be an ordinary charity.
